Please be aware that your local church reports are available for nearly 20 years by signing on to Ezra Statistics. On the top banner of the Statistics home page there is a drop down box to enter the year you want to work with. Choose the year you want and the Report Page Link will then allow you to run a report for that year. <https://ezra.gcfa.org/Statistics/ChurchCompletedForm.aspx>

The window will ask you for the Jurisdiction, District, and Church names. We are in the North Central Jurisdiction. When you get this far in Graphs you will have the following 10 year graph options: (Once we become the Michigan Conference these may go away.)
