

What is the New Testament?

1. The New Testament is a collection of 27 books written about the birth, life, death, and resurrection of Jesus, his followers, and the early church.
2. The New Testament has 4 main parts of writing: Gospels (good news about Jesus); Acts (history of the early church); Epistles (fancy word for letters); and Apocalyptic (about the end times)
