To Parents, May we suggest...

Relax! God put the wiggles in children. Do not feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome!

Sit towards the front where it is easier for your children and family to see what is going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of others! Quietly explain the parts of the worship service and actions of the pastors, worship leaders' choirs, etc. Help them find the hymns and scriptures in the hymnals and Bibles.

Sing the hymns, pray, participate in the liturgy Children learn about worship and liturgical behavior by copying you.

If you must leave worship with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said "Let the children come to me..."

Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the church, to God and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship.

Please let your children do their artwork, color, and make notes, and play with fidget toys. Children's activities are available at the entrance.

The presence of children is a gift to the Church and a reminder that our congregation is growing. Please welcome our children and give a smile of encouragement to their parents.

Ways to get involved

•Pray: We need you to mention us to God when you pray. This is a unique ministry never done before, so we need to lean on Jesus and our community of faith for guidance.

 Support Financially: We need help with items only used for the Special Needs community--rocker chairs, soft furniture, special lighting, comfort toys, special items for education (books, headphones, gadgets for comfort and training for ministry). We estimate a cost of \$2,000 per year for special items.

We will be partnering with Kulture City and Faith UMC in Canton Ohio for training and continued guidance to enhance this ministry. We have learned and listen to Jesus when he told the church, "Let the children come to me. Do not stop them! For the Kingdom of Heaven belongs to those who are like these children." We believe that this community is the blessed community and must know that the United Methodist church is their home also.

The budget: We estimate a budget to be more than \$25,000 per year with staffing of a 1/4 time Pastor, worship leader, and equipment needed for services and education for members. (Church Vibrancy Committee has committed to helping with Pastor salary plus for 3 years.)
