

Michigan Conference of The United Methodist Church EngageMI 2022 Full Application

This full application is required for a ministry or organization to be included as a new or renewed EngageMI project. Ministries already being reviewed and supported by another Michigan Conference Board or Division may fill out the abbreviated form. Forms must be completed and submitted by February 28, 2022.

What is EngageMI?

EngageMI is the mission giving engagement program for the Michigan Conference of The United Methodist Church. It challenges Michigan Conference congregations to participate in missional learning, giving and action with the goal of encouraging congregations to shift from transactional to relational ministry; from “ministry to” to “ministry with”.

The Michigan Conference Board of Global Ministries EngageMI program promotes local, national and international projects as well as mission personnel. Among them are United Methodist related mission and ministry projects located in Michigan, which are called Conference Christ-Centered Mission and Ministry (CCMM) Projects. What projects can be included in the EngageMI program?

Conference CCMM Projects should meet the following criteria:

- United Methodist related and located within Michigan
- Respect the inherent dignity and intrinsic worth of all people engaged in the ministry
- Include vulnerable and marginalized people in governance, strategic decision making and day-to-day leadership
- Transcend boundaries of race, class, social status, etc.
- Engage in both works of mercy and justice
- Include existing or emerging capacity to engage congregations across the conference in learning, giving and acting.
- Embrace an innovative or creative approach to mission and ministry
- Include an established leadership team, financial records and at least one year of operation

Note: An abbreviated form is available for projects that are overseen by a Michigan Conference Board or Division.
