No Cost Options

- <u>Michigan ICHAT</u> (Internet Criminal Access Tool)
 - Pros:
 - No cost for churches after approved application
 - Results are immediate
 - No social security number required
 - Cons:
 - Limited to Michigan records
 - Name-based
 - Results may not be accurate with a common name

Michigan Central Registry Clearance

- "Michigan's Central Registry is a repository of names of individuals who are identified as perpetrators related to a central registry case."
- Pros:
 - No cost
 - Individuals request the report themselves
- Cons:
 - Individuals request the report themselves
 - Takes more time
 - Limited information

Safe Gatherings

(Application, Reference Check, Background Checks, Training)

- <u>Safe Gatherings</u> (the Michigan Conference recommends Safe Gatherings for local churches and requires completion of SG requirements for individuals who wish to be authorized for district or conference related events or activities)
 - Pros
 - Includes application, reference check, background check, and training
 - Offers a training-only for youth under the age of 18
 - All records are kept by Safe Gatherings
 - Less work on staff
 - Training is consistent
 - Individuals who complete SG through their local church are also authorized for district/conference events
 - Cons
 - Some may find it cost-prohibitive
 - Ideally requires an additional training relevant to the local church
