





Societal Regression

"Society's emotional reactiveness in dealing with societal problems is similar to the years of slow build-up of an emotional breakdown of a family."

- Symptom 1st appears in the family.
- Family ignores or does enough to relieve immediate symptom.
- problem considered solved.
- usual course of behavior continues until another more serious symptom,
- followed by another superficial effort to relieve symptom.
- Process repeats until final breakdown, seen as unexpected.

MURRAY BOWEN on SOCIETAL REGRESSION

'There is a paradox in the rights-responsibility issue. The greater the anxiety, the greater the focus on "rights" that submerge "responsibility." There can be no rights without a responsible majority to guarantee the right.'


When there is more focus on one's rights, there is ...o less awareness of the rights of others, &o more irresponsibility in violating the rights of others. p. 279.




